The Christian says, however, that we come from God, and go back to Him. Our lives are full of meaning. Our origin and our destiny are important beyond measure.

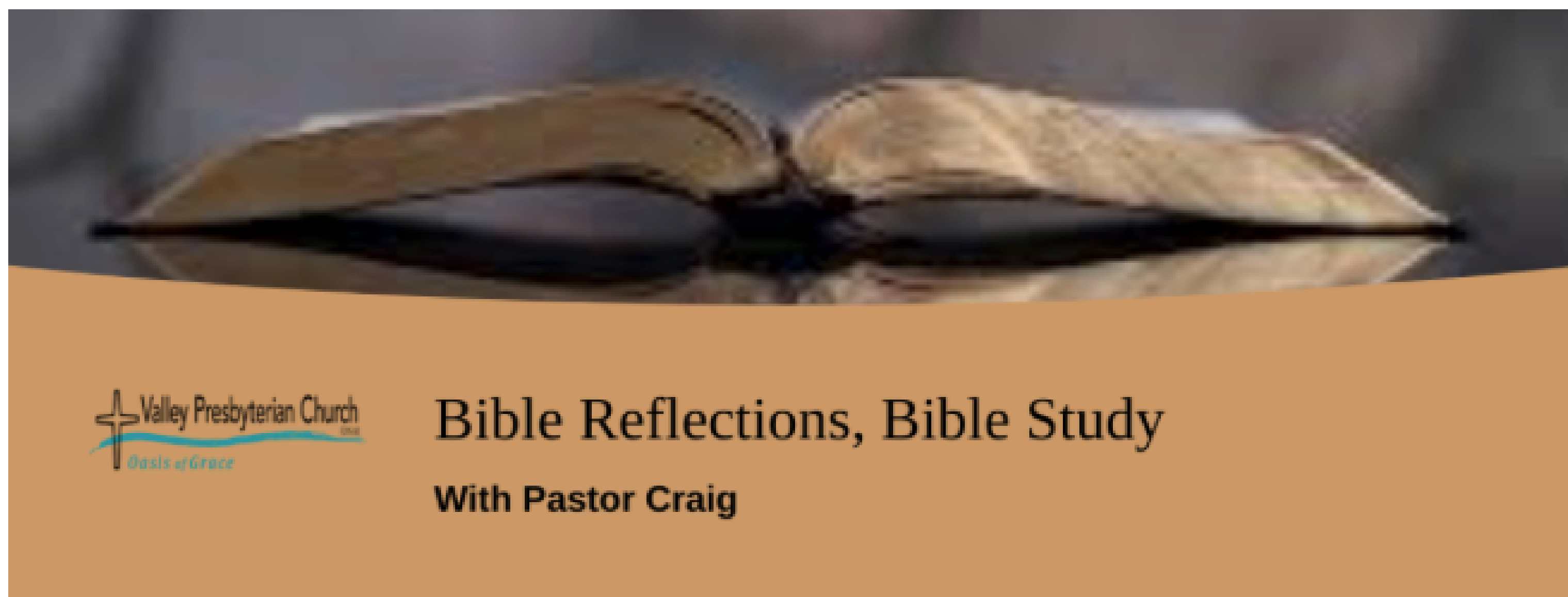
For five weeks we will confront the controversy and explore the wonder of God's creation (assuming we stay on track).
